67.01 PEDESTRIAN DEFINED. “Pedestrian” as it is used in this chapter means a person who is walking on foot, or a person who travels by way of roller blades, skateboards or in-line skates.

67.02 WALKING IN STREET. Pedestrians shall at all times when walking on or along a street, walk on the left side of the street.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.326)

67.03 HITCHHIKING. No person shall stand in the traveled portion of a street for the purpose of soliciting a ride from the driver of any private vehicle.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.331)

67.04 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING. Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.328)

67.05 USE SIDEWALKS. Where sidewalks are provided it is unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent street. Those pedestrians on roller blades, skateboards and in-line skates are exempted from this provision if they can show by a preponderance of the evidence that the condition of the sidewalk poses an unreasonable risk of injury to or threatens the safety of other pedestrians or themselves.
